

our society. It is one of Satan's greatest accomplishments. By it, he has deceived thousands by making them think they are true servants of God. From the Bible, we learn that denominationalism...

Ignores The Plan of God. God has told us what one must do to be saved. Hear (Romans 10:17), believe (Mark 16:16; John 8:24), repent (Acts 2:38), confess faith (Romans 10:9-10), and be baptized for the remission of sins (Acts 22:16) in order to be saved (1 Peter 3:21). Those in denominations deny this plan and replace it with man-made plans such as "Faith only" (James 2:24). God tells us we must remain faithful to Christ (Revelation 2:10). Denominationalism replaces this truth with the "Once saved always saved" doctrine which teaches that once one has become a child of God he can never so sin as to lose his salvation. A Christian can sin, if not, why does John tell them what to do when they do sin? (1 John 1:7-9)

Infects The People of God. If we're not careful, we find ourselves speaking and acting like those in the denominations. I have heard Christians refer to themselves as "A

Denominationalism is rampant in church of Christ," "or "A church of Christer;" just as a Baptist will refer to himself as a "Baptist," or a Methodist "A Methodist" A Christian is a member of the Lord's church: he is not a church. Some churches have been infected by the denominations. They have turned the Lord's church into a place of food, fun and frolic. "The kingdom of God is not eating and drinking..." (Romans 14:17). Some churches have introduced into their worship hand clapping, instrumental music and other elements foreign to the Gospel but common in denominations.

> Ignites The Passion of God. Many in denominations believe that God has blessed us in giving us so many different kinds of churches to choose But God is unhappy with from. religious division. When those at Corinth were beginning to denominate into "Paulites," "Apollosites," and "Cephasites" (1 Corinthians 1:12), Paul said to them "Now I plead with you brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment" (1 Corinthians 1:10). 🔎


