No one likes to be called names. Folks call others names out of anger, contempt, rudeness, prejudice or just plain meanness. You might be surprised to learn that God calls some people names; not for any of the above reasons, but simply to identify to people what they really are for the purpose of engendering within them a desire to change. For example, Proverbs 12:1 says, "Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge. But he who hates correction is stupid." God's word calls some people "stupid" here in order to instruct us to do better. Those identified as "stupid" are those who hate correction. All scripture is given to correct us (2

Timothy 3:16-17). Those who ignore or deny parts of God's word are stupid people (so says God). For example, those "Christians" who insist on the occasional alcoholic drink choose to ignore the prohibitions against it (1 Peter 4:3; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11). Those "Christians" who insist that homosexuality is acceptable to God choose to ignore the strong condemnation of the practice (Leviticus 18:22: Romans 1:25-28: 1 Corinthians 6:9-11). It's no fun being called names, but sometimes maybe we need to take the lesson. This is especially true where God's word is concerned. Don't be stupid, obey God! 🔎

We cannot Course of Escape. escape temptation; even Jesus Himself was submitted to such. But God has given us a way to escape each temptation, unscathed by sin (1 Corinthians 10:13). We must understand the ways of our enemy, the devil (1 Peter 5:8). He will use any means necessary, particularly deceit, in order to get us to sin. Smoking is associated with beauty and being cool. The ads don't depict charred lungs or cancer eaten mouths. Drinking is associated with parties and fun and good times. The ads don't depict the mangled cars and bodies: or the cancer eaten livers. God provides the way of escape, but we must choose to use it. We must depart from evil and do good (Psalm 37:27). Remember, God blesses those who resist temptation (James 1:12).

Consequences on Earth. Sin can bring devastating consequences in this

The Bible says that sin is lawlessness Life. "Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap" (Galatians 6:7). Drinking and drug abuse can lead to disease, loss of possessions, loss of family, loss of job, etc. Fornication can lead to a myriad of problems similar to the ones listed under drinking. Sin also has a ripple effect, it can hurt not only the sinner but innocent people as well. Sin also divides brethren from one another (1 Corinthians 5:1-11). Do not be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin (Hebrews 3:12-13).

Cost in Eternity. As a result of sin and the absence of repentance, the sinner will be saturated in suffering. The Bible speaks of the lake of fire, eternal punishment, extreme darkness, weeping and gnashing of teeth, no rest day or night, etc (Revelation 21:8; Mark 9:42-43; 2 Thessalonians 1:9; Matthew 25:30). Before you sin, ask yourself, "Is it really worth it, this brief moment of pleasure?" The sinner will also be separated from splendor. It's not only what the sinner receives, but also what he misses out on. He will be separated from the Lord and from the glory of His power (2 Thessalonians 1:9). Missing heaven and being cast into hell is a high price; are you willing to pay it?
