Confirmed Liar. The bible speaks of "The great dragon," "that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world" (Revelation 12:9). So the devil is a deceiver. Jesus said that he is the father of lies (John His words are deceptive. Whenever Satan is quoted as speaking in the Bible, it was always a lie! Or else he was using the truth in order to tempt, which is a misuse of truth, therefore a lie in itself. His own words confirm he is a liar! He lied to Eve in the garden when he told her she wouldn't die if she ate the forbidden fruit (Genesis 3:4-5). He tried to lie to Jesus in the wilderness (Matthew 4:5-6). He makes himself appear as an angel of light in order to deceive folks with religious error (2 Corinthians 11:13-15).

One can chose to be a child of God or a Satan we can find nothing about guilt; no regret, no second thoughts, no hint of remorse, nor the slightest scent of repentance. Matthew calls him "The tempter" (Matthew 4:3). Callousness brings moral defilement (Titus 1:15). Those who choose to follow the devil seem to be able to lie without blinking an eye. They can commit adultery or fornication with pride. I guarantee you it wasn't quite so easy the first time, but it got easier the more it was done. They became callous, just like their father the devil.

Condemned Loser. Satan is a loser! The devil has already been defeated. Someone once said that Satan is a decided fact, a destructive force, and a defeated foe! No one wants to join a team that is certain to lose. We want to be winners! We want to follow a winner. If you join his team, you'll enjoy the game, but you will not relish the victory because you are set to lose and the lake of fire is the prize. Matthew 25:41 says, "Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels:" Satan rules a doomed domain, and sails a sinking ship; why follow a loser?
