


Welcome to our services and thank you for visiting. If you have any questions about our beliefs or practices, please don't hesitate to ask.

THE SAINT VS. THE WORLDLY Michael Pickford

If you haven't noticed from the Bible that the child of God is to be different than the common man of the world then you've missed an essential theme in scripture. Sadly, it seems some have indeed missed this and it is evidenced by the way they dress, entertain themselves, speak, etc. Paul tells us that we are not to pattern ourselves after the world (Romans 12:1-2). Here are three ways that we are different from those in the world...

We Serve A Different Lord. Those in the world serve the lord of self. They are self driven and selfish. They strive to do whatever it takes to please themselves. But those in the Lord deny self in order to serve the Lord (Galatians 2:20; Matthew 10:37-39). Those in the world serve the lord of money. They love money and will do whatever it takes to acquire more of it. Money itself is spiritually neutral and is necessary to living in this world, but the love of it is treacherous, and many have denied the faith and made themselves miserable in their pursuit of more of it (1 Timothy 6:10). Paul called covetousness idolatry and the Lord said one cannot serve both God and riches (Colossians 3:5; Matthew 6:24)...

We Speak A Different Language. The world is interested in ungodly speech. They both use and entertain themselves with profanity (Romans 1:32). The saint desires pure speech; he strives to put filthy language out of his mouth (Colossians 3:8). The world speaks about rabbit's feet, four leaf clovers, and Horse shoes hanging over doors, while the Christian speaks to God in prayer about the things he needs, knowing that every good and perfect gift comes, not from some silly superstition, but from the Father of lights (Matthew 7:7-12, James 1:17). The worldly man pats himself on the back because he has food to eat, cars to drive, houses to live in, etc. The saint thanks the Lord humbly for supplying these things Thessalonians 5:17-18). The worldly man boasts of his accolades, his immorality, and his wickedness. The saint speaks from the housetops the Gospel of Jesus Christ (Matthew 10:27).

We Seek A Different Land. The worldly man has no hope beyond this life. His eternal destiny is a place of pain and punishment (Mark 9:42-48). The saint seeks a heavenly home. He enjoys indescribable peace while on earth because eternal life is his final destiny (1 Peter 1:3-4). *>*
