- GIVING: 1 Corinthians 16:1,2; 2 Corinthians 9:6,7



man, But its end is the way of death" (Proverbs 14:12). Someone once said. "Man's way leads to a hopeless end, God's way lead to an endless hope." Tragically, many are following man's way thinking they're following the ways of God...

Faith Alone. The concept of salvation by faith alone is not a new one. In fact, James spends an entire chapter exposing such a mentality as false (James 2). When Martin Luther, a Catholic Monk, rebelled against the Catholic church's meritorious mentality (Earn your salvation), he went to the other extreme of teaching the "Grace only" method of salvation. But James plainly stated, "You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only" (James 2:24). The Bible is clear that we can never earn our salvation with good works (Ephesians 2:8-10), but it is just as clear that without obedience we will never receive salvation (Hebrews 5:8-Jesus plainly said, "He who 9). believes and is baptized will Be saved..." (Mark 16:16).

Fruitless Activity. There is a right way and a wrong way to do things. This statement cannot not be truer in

"There is a way that seems right to a in any other realm than that of serving the Lord. Jesus spoke of some amazingly active religious people who would prophesy in His name, cast out demons, and do many wonders in His name (Matthew 7:21-22). When it came to religion, they were extremely active, yet their service did not produce fruit unto eternal life. The reason was that their activities, although good from man's standpoint, were not authorized by the Lord. Jesus said, "Depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness" (Matthew 7:23). Paul spoke of some who were lost because they had a zeal for God, but not according to His knowledge and direction. They wanted to do it their way (Romans 10:1-3).

> False Assurances. How sad it is when one takes comfort in a false Peace that is based on lies told by sincerely deceived people. Based on lies told by his loved ones, Jacob was fully convinced his son Joseph was dead, and was extremely emotional about it, but it wasn't true, Joseph was alive! (Genesis 37:32-36). Based on lies told by "Trusted, educated, and good people," many today are convinced they are saved, yet they have never obeyed the Lord's command (Mark 16:16). They go into eternity with a false assurance. Tragic! \sim

How exciting when a new baby arrives. Children are a gift from God (Psalm 127:3) and I've never seen any gift thrill anyone in so many different and wonderful ways.


