

FROM THE HEART Michael Pickford

speaks of the intellect, and it sometimes speaks of the seat of emotions. Sometimes it speaks of the conscience. The conscience is that little judge in our minds that either condemns or commends our actions (or inactions) (Romans 2:15). Consider...

When Our Heart Condemns Us. John wrote, "For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things" (1 John 3:20). John writes this in the context of loving, not just with words, but with actions. Love expressed by helping those in need. When we know to do good and do not do it, or when we do what we know to be wrong, our conscience condemns us. It keeps us up at night, makes us feel bad. If we think this is uncomfortable, remember that God is even greater than our hearts. We cannot keep anything from Him, and the punishment He will mete out will be far worse than the discomfort we derive from our "Guilty conscience."

When Our Heart Commends Us. It is far better for us to do what God says. John went on, "Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God" (1 John 3:21).

In the Bible, the heart sometimes This is written to Christians. Christians can neglect spiritual their responsibilities and sin, thus violating their conscience. This is a hindrance to praver. But when we do right, obey God and serve others, our conscience commends us, and we have more confidence when we pray (1 John 3:22). It is important for the non-christian to obey the Gospel through baptism (Mark 16:16; 1 Peter 3:21) as "The answer of a good conscience toward God." When one hears the Gospel, the hope is that his conscience will be pricked ("Cut to the heart" - Acts 2:37) and he will respond to his conscience by repenting and being baptized (Acts 2:38).

When Our Heart Confuses Us. The conscience is a safe-guard in religion, not a safe guide. The conscience can be deceived. There is such a thing as a false sense of security. One may feel in his heart that he is right with God, but if he hasn't obeyed the Gospel he is still lost in his sin (2 Thessalonians 1:7-9). Paul Thought he should be killing Christians, and did so with a clear conscience (Acts 26:9-11; Acts 23:1), but his conscience had been taught wrong, and therefore confused him. Don't rely on your conscience, rely on God's word! 🔎
