


Welcome to our services and thank you for visiting. If you have any questions about our beliefs or practices, please don't hesitate to ask.

SPIRITUAL LIBERTY Michael Pickford

National liberty and independence. But spiritual liberty is far superior. Jesus died on the cross to free us from our sins, to deliver us from certain eternal punishment, and to grant us a living hope of eternal life in the presence of the Lord. Spiritual liberty can be...

Acquired. "Stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made us free..." (Galatians 5:1). These had acquired liberty from sin. How? "For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ" (Galatians 3:26-27). Saul (Paul) was told to "Arise and be baptized and wash away your sins" (Acts 22:16). Baptism connects us with the blood of Christ and the blood then cleanses us, imparting liberty from our sins (Ephesians 1:7). Have you acquired spiritual liberty?

Abused. Some in Galatia were trying to abuse their spiritual liberty. Paul addressed a similar problem in Romans 6:1-2, "Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? Certainly not!" Paul urged the Galatians not to use their liberty as an opportunity for the flesh (Galatians 5:13). When we become Christians, we are not allowed

On July 4th we celebrated our to go on living any way we choose. Calvinism teaches that once saved, one can never so sin as to lose his salvation. Practically applied, this doctrine condones the concept of having your cake and eating it to. Just get saved then go ahead and enjoy the lusts of the flesh, vou can't lose vour spiritual liberty! Nonsense! Paul makes it clear that we must walk in the Sprit (vs 16), and those who insist on practicing the works of the flesh will not inherit the kingdom of God (Galatians 5:17-21).

Abandoned. It follows then that one can abandon his spiritual liberty. He can lose his salvation after having been cleansed. "You have become estranged from Christ' (Galatians 5:4). This statement inherently implies that they were in fact in Christ, and clearly teaches one can become estranged from Him. But Paul went on in this verse to say, "You have fallen from grace." Can one who is estranged from Christ be saved? Can one who has fallen from grace go to heaven? If it's impossible to fall from grace then how could Paul even make such a statement? Paul told the Galatians to "Stand fast therefore in the liberty..." (Galatians 5:1). Don't abandon your liberty in Christ, remain faithful till death (Revelation 2:10).
