

ribs (Genesis 2:21-22) after He had declared that it was not good for man to be alone. Her name means. "Life" or "Living" and we are told she was "The mother of all living" (Genesis 3:20). From Eve, we can learn a lesson about ...

SUBMISSION. The woman was created for the man, not the man for the woman (1 Corinthians 11:8). Paul used this to argue the proper "Chain of command" (1 Corinthians 11:3). This concept angers many modern women, but it need not. This is not a superiority/inferiority issue. The man is not superior to the woman, or vice versa; but God has in fact placed them in different roles with unique responsibilities. In the home, God has made man the head (Ephesians 5:23) and if there is to be any peace and happiness at all within the marriage, the woman will respect this God given role even when she disagrees with a decision her husband has made (Ephesians 5:33). And the husband is to be a loving leader, not a brutish boss. If he will lovingly lead, chances are, she will faithfully follow.

SIN. We learn something about Satan and sin from Eve's interaction

God created Eve from one of Adam's with that serpent of old (Genesis 3). Satan is conniving and scheming. He immediately contradicted what God had told Adam and Eve. Eve was foolish for even giving the Devil a hearing. We'd all be better off if she had simply walked away from him at the outset (James 4:7). What about us? Why ask God to "lead us not into temptation" and then walk headlong into certain dangerous scenarios? We also learn how deceptive sin is. Eve was deceived into thinking the forbidden fruit would render satisfaction (Genesis 3:13: 1 Timothy 2:14). Liquor ads don't display rank livers. Smoking ads don't boast of blackened lungs. Don't be taken in by the deceitfulness of sin (Hebrews 3:13).

SALVATION. In the midst of issuing a grueling punishment, God made a glorious promise (Genesis 3:14-16). The Seed of woman shall bruise Satan's head! The promise spoke of the Christ, the Messiah, the Anointed One, the Son of God who would exemplify God's love (Romans 5:6-9) and save the world from their sins (John 1:29). Indeed, that seed was Christ! (Galatians 3:16). Obey Him in order to receive your eternal salvation (Hebrews 5:8-9; Mark 16:16). 🔎

"He has sent redemption to His people; He has commanded His covenant forever; Holy and awesome is His name." -Psalm 111:9


I recently read an arrest record online for a man named Michael Pickford. He had been charged with aggravated Before you get too burglary. concerned, let me assure you this was not me. But he has the same name! I wondered what would happen if he lived in the same town as I do and acted like this. What would people think of me? Would they think it was me?

Holy (Psalm 111:9). In fact, the Bible goes on to admonish us in this regard, "But as he who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, 'Be holy, for I am *holy;*" (1 Peter 1:15-16).

The word for "Holy" speaks of being

Set apart for God's use. And Peter speaks of our "Conduct." As one who wears the name of Christ, one who is a child of the One Whose name is "holy," it is essential that I represent that name well. I'm part of the household of God and I must conduct myself in the world in such a way as to bring honor to the family name -God's spiritual family! (1 Timothy 3:15).

The world is watching me! If I don't live right they will find out. They will be disgusted by my conduct and possibly be turned off when it comes to serving God. By contrast, I should have my "conduct honorable among The Bible tells us that God's name is the Gentiles, that...they may, by [my] good works which they observe, glorify God..." (1 Peter 2:12). Or as the Lord put it, "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven" (Matthew 5:16). Protect the family name! 🔎


