

the world, this would be nice, but it wouldn't save us from our sins. God demonstrated His love for us in that while we were treating Him like an enemy, He sent His beloved Son to suffer at Calvary for our sins (Read Romans 5:6-9). In turn, God insists that we demonstrate our love for Him through obedience (John 14:21; 1 John 5:2-3). But God also commands us to demonstrate our love for others. It helps to tell others we love them, but our actions say "I love you" much more convincingly than our words. We can say "I love you" with...

COMFORT. God comforts us in ways we could never match. Yet He also wants us to comfort one another. Paul wrote "Comfort one another with these words" (1 Thessalonians 4:18). Also, "Comfort each other and edify one another..." (1 Thessalonians 5:11). Do we criticize when we should be comforting? Visit a friend in the hospital, speak a kind word to the hurting, be there when they are weak; Come to your brother's side!...

CARE. We express our love by caring for the needs of others. "By this we know love, because he laid down His life for us. And we also ought to

If God merely said "I love you" to lay down our lives for the brethren. But whoever has this worlds goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him? My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth" (1 John 3:16-18). Don't just say it, show it. Don't just declare it, demonstrate it! When we see a brother in need, let's not look for reasons not to help! I'm thankful God didn't say, "They shouldn't have sinned!" "They shouldn't have gotten themselves into this mess." "I warned them what would happen." God demonstrated His love unconditionally, so must we!... Our

hypersensitive society teaches us that it's "Unloving" to offend. But the Lord taught, "If your brother sins against you, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him" (Luke 17:3). I'm not doing anyone any favors by turning a blind eve to their sins. If they don't repent, they'll lose their soul. Regardless of how unpleasant it is for the moment for both parties, rebuke is the loving thing to do. Remember, "Faithful are the wounds of a friend, But the kisses of an enemy are deceitful" (Proverbs 27:6). "I Love You!" Say it! And Show it!

"Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord." -1 Corinthians 15:58

Suppose you were sitting in a coffee shop waiting for your coffee. The waitress comes over and sets an empty cup on your table before you. She then tilts up the coffee pot over the cup, and with great straining and exertion does all she can to allow only one small droplet to fall from the pot into your cup. She then walks away.

A droplet?! That's not even enough to taste! On the other hand, suppose she turns the pot up over your cup and begins to pour the coffee. The cup fills up, but she keeps pouring. The cup overflows in the saucer, but she keeps pouring. The saucer overflows onto the table, but she keeps pouring. The coffee fills the table and overflows into the floor. etc.

The Greek word in the above passage for "Abounding" is very interesting. When I looked it up in my Bible software, the first words that appeared in the definition were "to superabound (in quantity or quality), be in excess," IN excess!

It seems that sometimes Christians are straining with great exertion to offer the Lord only a droplet. We work harder to get out of work than we would if we actually went to work for the Lord! A song we sometimes sing says, "To the work, to the work..." What a grand thought! If your work record at your workplace looked like your work record in the Kingdom of the Lord, what would be the result of your one year evaluation? Would you get a raise? Or would you get a demotion, or possibly even fired?

What about me? Am I offering the Lord a droplet, or am I superabounding in the work of the Lord? Let us help one another be "Zealous for good works" (Hebrews 10:24; Titus 2:14).
