even sincere active ones, who are laboring under the impression that they are faithfully serving the Lord. The Lord addressed such people in Matthew 7:21-23. In these few verses. we see their...

FAITH. There is the type of obedient faith that saves one's soul, and then there are those who believe in Jesus, but do not obey Him. The folks described in these verses undoubtedly believed in Jesus. In fact, they said to Him, "Lord, Lord." Faith is necessary unto salvation, but so much more is involved. One must respond to their faith and obey the Gospel. "You see then that a man is justified by works and not by faith only" (James 2:24). Jesus is the Author of salvation to those who "Obey" Him (Hebrews 5:8-"Eternal destruction" awaits "Those who do not obey the Gospel of Lord Jesus Christ" Thessalonians 1:8-9).

FERVOR. Those in Matthew 7:21-23 were undoubtedly fervent in their work. Jesus didn't deny that they had indeed "Prophesied," "Cast out demons," and performed "Many wonders." From man's perspective these folks had a one way ticket to

There are many religious people, eternal life. It's sad that many saints today lack the fervor that these possessed. Paul enjoins saints to be "Not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord" (Romans 12:11). You can be certain that Satan and his angels didn't suffer from inactivity. If many Christians would serve the Lord as Christians with the same diligence that they served sin before they were converted churches everywhere would be growing by leaps and bounds. Remember, Christ died for us that we might be "Zealous for good works" (Titus 2:14).

FAULT. Those in Matthew 7:21-23 believed in Jesus, and they were very fervent in their religious activities, yet Jesus gave them the death sentence. He stated that He never knew them! Why? The problem is to be found in the concept of authority. While they were active and religious, they practiced things the Lord did not authorize. He said, "You who practice lawlessness." They acted as if there were no law. Their works were good from man's perspective, but they had no authority for them. They went beyond the doctrine of Christ and their works were not all in the name of the Lord (2 John 9; Colossians 3:17). A
