COMMITMENT

"Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass. 6 He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, And your justice as the noonday" (Psalm 37:5-6). Someone who truly trusts the Lord will be committed to serving Him, regardless of the cost or obstacles. Notice commitment...

Required. If we would be a true servant of the Lord, someone who is truly devoted to Him, someone who has a genuine hope of going to heaven, we must be committed to doing His will fervently and relentlessly. The Lord said, *"But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you"* (Matthew 6:33). What did the Lord say was necessary to inherit "Eternal life?" *"And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or wife or children or lands, for My name's sake, shall receive a hundredfold, and inherit eternal life"* (Matthew 19:29). That's a tall order! God doesn't call us to half-hearted, willy-nilly service, but to full service, ready to give up, if necessary, those things that are the nearest and dearest to us for His cause.

Removed. It's not difficult to see

when someone's commitment to the Lord has waned. Personally, he's letting his daily bible reading and study lapse (Acts 17:11); his personal prayer time has been reduced to little or nothing (1 Thessalonians 5:17); his speech isn't as graceful in the home or workplace; and he doesn't mention the Lord to his friends, neighbors, etc. One of the first symptoms we as brethren notice is that he doesn't seem as diligent about coming to Bible studies, then he begins to miss the assemblies of the saints. His presence cannot be counted on (Hebrews 10:25). How sad! But we must remember that our brother is beginning to be deceived by the evil one; we must come to his rescue! He's become weak and our responsibility is not to run him in the ground, but to help him out of the ditch (1 Thessalonians 5:14). Ultimately, this sometimes requires loving discipline, but we must help him get recommitted (1 Corinthians 5:4-5).

Rewarded. Being committed offers great rewards while here on earth - peace, comfort, hope, satisfaction. But ultimately, our reward for complete devotion to the Lord will be just as Jesus said - *"Eternal life"* (Matthew 19:29). ☞

FIVE VIEWS OF MARK 16:16 (1)

The Lord said, "He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned" (Mark 16:16). Ever since the Lord made this statement man has been denying it, distorting it, or dismissing it. Over the next few weeks we'll discuss five different views folks take on this passage.

The first view says, "He who believes and is baptized will NOT be saved." This view is taken by the atheists – those who do not believe in God. If they do not believe in God, they obviously do not believe in His Son and so therefore deny the Lord's statement altogether. Nor do they believe in heaven or hell or eternal salvation of any kind.

But the fact is that God does exist. It defies intelligence to observe the

magnificent creation around us and deny that a powerful Being did not create it. "The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork. Day unto day utters speech, And night unto night reveals knowledge" (Psalm 19:1-2).

Jews, Muslims, Hindus and other religious people also deny the necessity of baptism for salvation. Jews reject Jesus as the Messiah. The others, while they do believe in some type of "God," deny that salvation is through Christ. But the Bible clearly reveals that one can come to God only through Jesus (John 14:6). One passage dispels the error of Atheists, Jews, Muslims, etc. It's 1 Timothy 2:5-6, "For there is one God and one Mediator between God and man, the Man Christ Jesus, Who gave Himself a ransom for all..."
