of the Lord's Supper is to "Proclaim the Lord's death till he comes" (1 Corinthians 11:26). During its observance, we are to lay aside all other thoughts and focus solely upon that great sacrifice of Love – Christ on the cross!

The observance of the Lord's supper can be perverted, as is evidenced by a reading of 1 Corinthians 11:17-34. The purpose of the supper is not to provide a meal in order to fulfill the partakers' appetites. "If anyone is hungry, let him eat at home." (1 Corinthians 11:34).

The very purpose of the observance exemplified in Acts 20:7. It is not to be observed at home, on the side of the road, in the back room, et. al., but rather when the local church comes "Together as a church" "In one place" (1 Corinthians 11:18, 20). Paul and his companions waitied till the "Disciples *came together*" to partake (Acts 20:7).

Some churches make their observance long and drawn out. That's fine, so long as they don't bind that on others nor think other churches "Less spiritual" for not doing the same. The Lord kept it simple. He blessed and broke the bread, and then the cup, accompanied by a very "Short talk" (Matthew 26:26-29). P



you'll learn that they prefer to be called "Latter Day Saints." We often refer to them as "Mormons" but traditionally they have found this offensive. Let's make three basic observations about this prevalent religious organization....

Their Couriers. Most of us have experienced that knock on the door. We open it up to find two very young men dressed nicely and wearing name tags with the title "Elder" on them. These young men are their primary couriers of their beliefs. When I was still a teen I had my first study with a couple of these "Elders." The first thing I asked them about was their name tags. I explained to them that the very word elder implied an older man, one with age. I then took them to the qualifications for "Elders" in Titus 1:5-9. We didn't have to get too far because neither of them was the "Husband of one wife," and neither had "Faithful children;" or any children for that matter. They were children themselves! Are God's qualifications not important?

Their Creeds. I then asked them if the Bible was the only true source of authority. They said, "inasmuch as it

If you ever speak to these folks is translated and transmitted correctly." I soon learned that what they meant by this is that whenever the Bible disagrees with Mormon doctrine, then the Bible must have been mistranslated. Such an easy out! In fact, the Mormon church recognizes four Creed books. The Book of Mormon (Primarily), The Pearl of Great Price, Doctrines and Covenants, and finally the Bible. On the front of their book of Mormon it said, "Another Testament of Jesus Christ." I pointed out Galatians 1:6-9 where we're told that those who preach another Gospel were "Accursed." The Gospel is to be our only "Creed" in religion (2 John 9).

Their Commendability. The only thing I can commend them in is what Paul commended his Jewish brethren in, "For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge" (Romans 10:2). But zeal without the proper knowledge condemns (See Romans 10:1, 3). However, we must remember that the right knowledge without zeal will also condemn. Perhaps we could learn from the sacrifices they make in spreading their message. God calls on us to be zealous people. We have the truth, let's get it out to the lost! (Titus 2:14; Acts 8:4). 🔎
