THE PERFECT FATHER Michael Pickford

A friend of mine who had several children once told me that he started out at a very young age as a father. He was still a kid himself, and was overwhelmed with the prospect of raising children. He finally decided that the best course to follow was to look to the perfect Father – God. He raised seven children, all of whom are now adults, all of whom are faithful Christians, and all his children who are married have spouses who are faithful Christians. What a legacy! In the Bible, we see that God, as the perfect Father...

Provides. In a general sense, God is the Father of all mankind in that He created all of us. The Lord taught that in a general sense God provides for all of His creation. "For He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust" (Matthew 5:45). But God has especially promised to provide for His children in Christ, both physically and Physically, He has spiritually. promised to provide those who seek Him first with food, clothing, and shelter (Matthew 6:25-34). Spiritually, Paul tells us that God "Has blessed us with every spiritual blessing..." (Ephesians 1:3); and Peter tells us

that God "Has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness" (2 Peter 1:3). James reminds us that "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights" (James 1:17). A loving earthly father will also provide for his children both physically and spiritually (1 Timothy 5:8; Ephesians 6:1-4).

Protects. God is clearly seen in the Bible as a great protector of His children. "I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; For You alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety" (Psalm 4:8). Through the full armor of God, God has provided us the protection we need from our adversary the devil (Ephesians 6:10-18). A Loving earthly father will provide protection for his children. Many fathers are abusive, and their children fear they will be harmed or even killed by their father. What a tragedy! Fathers need to seek to protect their children both physically and spiritually.

Punishes. Down through the ages, God has punished His children because He loves them (Hebrews 12:5-11). The Bible says, "He who spares his rod hates his son, But he who loves him disciplines him promptly" (Proverbs 13:24). 🔑

WARNING: THE ONLY ACCEPTABLE CRITICISM IS TO CRITICIZE THOSE WHO CRITICIZE!

Does that make sense? This seems to be the case these days. It's true that God hates "One who sows discord among brethren" (Proverbs 6:19b), but is this not speaking of those who stir up strife over personal opinions? After all, the Lord Himself sent His disciples into the world with a message that He knew would cause stark division between the closest, most intimate of relationships (Matthew 10:34-39).

There are some who have a knack for picking fights (arguments) and causing dissension over spiritually irrelevant matters. The Bible would call these folks "Quarrelsome" (1 Timothy 3:3). But in our zeal to eradicate this devilish disposition among us, let's not forget that sometimes a spiritual battle is necessary, and division is called for. When authentic false doctrine rears its ugly head, are we not to "Contend for the faith?" (Jude 3).

When some were trying to substitute a false plan of salvation (Physical circumcision) for God's true plan of salvation, isn't it true that "Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and dispute with them?" (Acts 15:1-2). Yes, that's the same Barnabas who was the great encourager, yet when error threatened, he fought! He criticized that error! One should be a great encourager, but the most encouraging thing he can do when religious error threatens is to stand up and fight against it!

In the face of being criticized for criticizing religious error, let's fight anyway. Let's pray for the courage we need to "Watch, stand fast in the faith, be brave, be strong" (1 Corinthians 16:13).
