

## IGNORING GOD Michael Pickford

God said through the prophet Hosea, "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge" (Hosea 4:6). The rest of the verse goes on to explain the reason for their lack of knowledge. It was because they chose to be ignorant by rejecting the knowledge of God. Sadly, there are many today in the religious world at large who are making this same mistake. They are rejecting the knowledge of God - Christ's Gospel, and substituting in its place their own wisdom or the wisdom of other men. Paul wrote of such people in Romans 10:3, "For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God." Consider some ways in which men today ignore God's righteousness.

**Many teach a system of "Faith Only" salvation**. They contend that all one has to do to be saved is believe on Jesus as the Son of God. Their basis for this teaching is a perversion of Romans 5:1 which states that we have been justified by faith. No one denies faith as a necessity for salvation, but the text never said faith "only." These folks ignore what God said in James 2:24, "You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only."

**Some try to ignore the fact that the Old Testament has been done away with.** They seek to authorize some of their religious practices based on something taught under the Law of Moses. They ignore such passages as Hebrews 8:7-13 which plainly teaches that the old law has been made obsolete by the bringing in of the new covenant (vs. 13). The entire book of Galatians is dedicated to a discussion of how the old Law has been done away with.

Most of the religious world ignore the plain statements God's word has made about Baptism being necessary unto salvation. Jesus stated, "He who believes and is baptized shall be saved" (Mark 16:16). Paul taught in many places that baptism saves (Rom. 6:1-4; Gal. 3:26,27; Col. 2:12, etc.). Peter also made clear the necessity of baptism for salvation (Acts 2:38). He stated in 1 Peter 3:21, "There is also an antitype which now saves us - baptism (not the removal of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God), through the resurrection of Jesus Christ." Don't be guilty of ignoring God.  $\rho$

We may have not met God face to face, yet. However, this does not mean we do not have the capability to know who God is. The Bible spares no details in describing who our Heavenly Father is and is not.

The problem is this — many only want to look at the "good" and "positive" attributes of God. God is love, God is light, and God is fair. These are all very true. But these same folks refuse to admit there is a "jealous" side to God — a side that will not, in any way, tolerate competitors. Peter made this very clear in his writings.

"For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them down to hell, and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment" (II Peter 2:4).

"And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of righteousness, bringing in the flood upon the world of the ungodly" (II Peter 2:5).

"And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah into ashes condemned them with an overthrow, making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly" (II Peter 2:6).

Think of some of the phrases in these verses. "Spared not...bringing in the flood...turning cities into ashes." And think about this phrase that applies directly to you and me — "making them an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly."

We have been Divinely warned. We have no excuse or reason to offer as to why we have lived an ungodly life.

On this day, I am very happy that God is love and light and that He only wishes for my repentance (II Peter 3:9). But on this day, I should be acutely aware that He also will be highly displeased with my ungodly living. And as we have read, such actions bring disastrous consequences.

Today, let every action and thought be that which is pleasing to God. Strive to please Him, not man. After all, in the end that is all which matters.. -
