God has not only commanded us to worship Him, but has also told us how, in His word. The elements of our services, as prescribed by God's word, are as follows:



APPLICATION! APPLICATION! APPLICATION! Michael Pickford

The three most important words in Real Estate are, "Location, Location, Location!" A beautiful spacious home is of little value if located in a dirty, crime ridden part of town; while a smaller modest home located in a clean, quiet neighborhood is of greater value. When following Christ, the three most important words are "Application, Application, Application!"

Consider What Jesus Taught. Jesus often emphasized the need to apply His teachings. Knowledge of God's word is essential, but knowledge is a means to an end, the end being obedience. Knowledge is of little value if not properly and diligently applied. Jesus ended His sermon on the mount with a call to action in the story of the two builders. The foolish man was foolish because, while he gained knowledge (He heard the sayings of Jesus), he failed to apply the teachings to his life. The wise builder was wise because he both heard and did (Matthew 7:24-27). Who really loves Jesus? "He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me" (John 14:21).

Consider What James Taught. James stressed the need to apply God's word. "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves" (James 1:22). Those who insist that all one has to do is believe (Faith only) are deceiving themselves, according to James. James 2:14-26 is a strong dissertation committed solely to highlighting the fact that just having belief, without application, equals nothing more than a "Dead" faith (James 2:17). Even the demons believe and tremble! Are demons saved? (James 2:19). "You see then that a man is justified by works, and not by faith only" (James 2:24). Application! Obedience!

Consider What Jews Taught. Not all Jews! But many of the religious teachers of Jesus' day taught many things that they themselves would not put into application. "For they say, and do not do" (Matthew 23:3). This calls to mind many of the "Religious leaders" of our day. Most actually teach the concept of "Faith only" salvation. To them, if one must apply the Lord's teachings, this equals obedience, which is the same as "Works." They teach that if one must work to get salvation, then grace is nullified. It's not so. Christ on the cross was grace, a free gift that man didn't deserve (earn). But to access the result of that grace - salvation, one must obey (Hebrews 5:9).
