### Acts 26:28, Agrippa's Statement defeats...

UNIVERSALISM: Some believe that God is a loving God Who will not send anyone to hell. It is true that God loves everyone, this is why He sent His Son to die for the world. But His just nature will not allow Him to allow entrance into heaven for anyone who does not obey His Son (Hebrews 5:8-9; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9). Sadly, the majority will be condemned (Matthew 7:13-14).

CALVINISM: Calvinism teaches that man does not have free will to choose to serve God and go to heaven. But Agrippa realized that one can be persuaded to become a christian. Heaven and hell are the two eternal destinations available to men, and each man and woman chooses his own destination by choosing either to serve God or not to serve God (Joshua 24:15).

DENOMINATIONAL NAMES: Agrippa recognized that Paul was trying to persuade him to become, not a Methodist, or a Baptist, etc, but a "Christian." This is the new Name God chose for His people and this is the only name by which we can be saved (Isa 62:2; Acts 11:26; Acts 4:12). Those who sought to be called by any other name were rebuked for it (1 Corinthians 1:10-17).

# SUFFICIENT GRACE Michael Pickford

Much is said in scripture about the grace of God. Let's consider three essentials...

Salvation. We are saved by God's grace (Ephesians 2:9-10). That is to say, we have the opportunity to obey God and be saved because He has freely given us this opportunity by sending His Son to die for our sins. We did nothing to deserve this free gift, but God, because of His great love for us, sent His Son to die for undeserving, ungodly sinners (Romans 5:6-9). This grace, this opportunity to obey God and be saved, is available to all of mankind. It appeared to all men (Titus 2:11), and it is to be preached to all men (Mark 16:15). You, regardless of how sinful you have been in life, have this opportunity of salvation before you. Obey the Lord and be saved (Hebrews 5:8-9; Mark 16:16).

<u>Sufficiency</u>. Folks wonder why faithful saints get sick and die young, or why they suffer other devastating things in life. They question God's love in this. Remember though, even the apostle Paul suffered with a "Thorn in the flesh." He asked God repeatedly for relief from it, but God's answer was no, "My Grace is Sufficient for you" (2 Corinthians 12:9). The answer to questions like, "Why does God allow cancer," Why does God allow wicked men to murder the innocent," "Why do good people suffer," is that ultimately, God is more concerned about our eternal salvation than He is about our physical health. In fact, He uses these earthly challenges to strengthen our faith (1 Peter 1:6-9). His grace is sufficient for us in that if He never does another thing for us, it's enough that He has sent His Son to die for our sins and provide for us an entrance into the joys of heaven.

Sacrifice. God's grace, His Son on the cross, teaches us that we should be willing to sacrifice the sinful pleasures of this life for Him. It teaches us that we should be "Denying ungodliness and worldly lusts," and that "We should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age" (Titus 2:11-12). We should deny the worldly pleasure of this life so that we might have eternal pleasures in eternal life (Titus 2:13). Christ gave Himself for us that we might offer our lives in this body as a living sacrifice for Him (Titus 2:14; Romans 12:1-2).

**Problems**. The Homosexual agenda is fast becoming more than just a thorn in the flesh to those who want to serve God. It is threatening our freedom of religion, common sense, and public safety. <u>Prayers</u>. One step we can and must take is to take it to the Lord in prayer. "Therefore I exhort first of all that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence, for this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior" (1 Timothy 2:1-3). We need to be praying against these laws that restrict our freedom and the peace we enjoy to worship God and preach the Gospel.

Protests. There are some who protest wickedness by resorting to violence. These will bomb abortion clinics, and physically attack and harm homosexuals. This is not biblical and it is not Christ-like in any sense of the word. One way we can protest these things is by voting. Some say we should completely separate religion and politics. Nonsense! Do they really believe our service to God shouldn't influence every aspect of our lives, including how we vote? There are still politicians out there who oppose things like abortion, and the homosexual agenda. They support the religious freedom to preach against these things. Why would you not try to get them into office? Why would one pray for religious freedom and then support individuals and parties who want to rob us of these freedoms? We also protest against these evils by not being silent, but by trying to teach our friends and neighbors the biblical truths on these matters, and by preaching against these evils from our pulpits. Let's strive to protect our religious freedom in a biblical manner!
