Go To THE FISH!

Many times in scripture we are directed to living things in the world in order to glean spiritual lessons. The Lord Himself directed people to the birds of the air and the lilies of the field in order to learn to trust in God for the provision of daily necessities (Matthew 6:25-34). The Proverbs writer invites the "Sluggard" to consider the ant in order to learn the importance of diligent labor (Proverbs 6:6-11). In this article, I want us to visit the river, creek, pond, or aquarium and learn some spiritual lessons from fish...

BE VIGILANT. Fish are very quick to escape their predators. They seem to be very watchful for any possible danger. We have an adversary who seeks to devour us, and we are told that we must be vigilant (watchful for danger). Rather than seeking opportunities to sin, we should be seeking opportunities to escape such! **HUNGER AND THIRST FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS**. I'm told that some fish don't possess a mechanism that tells them they are full. They will gorge themselves to death, so one must be careful about how much food to put in the tank. Do I have such an insatiable appetite when it comes to feeding from the word of God? The Lord teaches us to hunger and thirst for righteousness. Our desire to be righteous

engenders our desire for what makes us righteous – a knowledge of God's word!

KEEP GROWING. I'm also told that some fish never stop growing for the duration of their life. This is how it should be with Christians! Peter tells us to desire the pure milk of the word that we may grow thereby (1 Peter 2:2).. Even a wise and well educated man has much to learn (Proverbs 1:5). But taking in knowledge of God's word daily isn't enough, we must seek to use it through living and teaching it, so that by reason of use we may learn the difference between what is good and what is not, then avoid the bad while diligently pursuing the righteous things (Hebrews 5:12-14; 1 Timothy 6:11).

SWIM AGAINST THE CURRENT. Trout will swim in place into the stream in order to catch insects, worms, and other food that's floating downstream. Being a Christian often seems to be an uphill battle, a swim against the current. The trout is willing to do so for the reward. We must keep our eternal reward in mind in order to keep from giving up and being carried away (Rev 2:10; 2 Cor 4:16-18).

- 6) Christians who do "Not obey" God's word are to be disfellowshipped: 2
