Daily Bible Study by Michael Pickford

This Week's Theme: Becoming A Christian Weekly Memory Verse: Acts 11:26

Introduction: Young children dream of becoming great things when they grow up. Some want to be firemen, some policemen, some doctors, etc. It is certainly healthy to teach our young children to aspire to great things. The greatest aspiration of everyone should be to become a Christian. Sadly, many never experience the urge to become children of God, and sadder still, most who do experience such an urge end up being taught the wrong way to do so. Salvation by faith alone is the most popular doctrine in the "Christian" religion even though the Bible specifically says that a man is not justified by "Faith only" (James 2:24). The Bible clearly teaches that one must "Obey" in order to obtain salvation (Hebrews 5:8-9) and avoid eternal punishment (2 Thessalonians 1:7-9). This week, let's investigate the Bible and consider what it says regarding what man must do in order to become a child of God.

Monday: The first step to becoming a Christian is to hear the Gospel.

- 1. Romans 10:17: How does faith come?
- 2. Mark 16:15; Matthew 28:18-19: Why do you suppose Jesus would tell His disciples to preach the Gospel to all nations, to every creature?
- 3. Romans 10:9-10: What two things must be done according to these verses?
- 4. Did the first converts (Acts 2) hear the Gospel? (Acts 2:14, 37).

<u>Tuesday</u>: After Hearing the gospel, one must believe that Jesus is God's Son.

- 1. John 8:24: What will happen to those who do not believe that Jesus is God's son?
- 2. Mark 16:16: There are two things stated in this verse that one must do in order to "be saved." What's the first thing?
- 3. Did the first converts (Acts 2) believe? (Acts 2:37).

<u>Wednesday</u>: After Hearing and Believing, one must repent of his sins.

- 1. Luke 13:3-5: What will happen to the one who does not repent?
- 2. Acts 17:30: What does God command all men to do?
- 3. Did the first converts (Acts 2) repent? (Acts 2:38).

<u>Thursday</u>: After Hearing, Believing, and Repenting, one must confess his faith.

- 1. Romans 10:9-10: What must one confess? What is confession made unto?
- 2. After the eunuch stated his desire to be baptized, What did Philip state that he must do first? How did the Eunuch respond? Was this a confession of faith?

<u>Friday</u>: After Hearing, Believing, Repenting, and confessing, one is still not a Christian until he is Baptized into Christ.

- 1. Mark 16:16: Jesus named two things that one must do in order to "Be saved." What are they? Was Jesus giving a multiple choice here, or did He say that both of these things must be done?
- 2. Isaiah 59:1-2; Acts 22:16; Acts 2:38: What separates man from God? Does it stand to reason that if one wants to be reunited with God (saved), he must remove that which separates? What is Saul told to do in order to wash away his sins? (Acts 22:16). What were those in Acts 2 told to do "for the remission of sins?"
- 3. 2 Timothy 2:10; Galatians 3:26-27: Where is salvation located? (2 Tim. 2:10). How does one get into Christ, put Him on? (Gal. 3:26-27). Can one get into Christ without baptism? Can one be saved unless he gets into Christ?
- 4. Acts 8:38-39; Acts 10:47-48: Is it water baptism that saved those mentioned in these two passages?
- 5. Colossians 2:12: Where these people sprinkled or were they immersed (buried)? Does sprinkling suffice when it comes to being baptized?
- 6. Note: Remaining faithful after becoming a Christian is essential to finally going to heaven (Revelation 2:10).
