

JESUS IN 2 SAMUEL

“He shall build a house for My name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.”

2 Samuel 7:13 NKJV

David desired to build a permanent place of worship for God (2 Samuel 7:1-2), but because of the blood on his hands (1 Chronicles 28:3), David was told that he would not be granted that opportunity. His son would. Solomon was indeed born, and he did build the temple of God in Jerusalem (1 Kings 6), but that temple was destroyed by Babylon (2 Chronicles 36:19).

Though dark was the day the temple was destroyed, hope was on the horizon. For the Christ was to come and fulfill in complete form the promise made to David. Jesus came and built a spiritual temple (John 2:19) and He reigns on His throne forever. Jesus is the true Priest King and He is ours.


Have you accepted His reign? Is He your Priest? To accept and follow, you must begin by obeying. Obedience begins by believing in Him which includes confessing Him (Romans 10:8, 9), repenting of our sins (Acts 2:28), being baptized into Christ (Galatians 3:27), and living faithfully until death (Revelation 2:10). -

JESUS IN GENESIS

“The scepter shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet until Shiloh comes; and to Him shall be the obedience of the people.” -Genesis 49:10

On the eve of his death, Jacob gave his sons blessings. To Judah, his fourth born, he spoke the words quoted above. This is interesting because Reuben was his first born and should have been the ruler, but, he sinned and lost the right. But, to add to it, Jacob gave the birthright to his eleventh born. Joseph’s sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, both received a land inheritance equal to the other tribes therefore making Joseph’s house have double portions. However, by the inspiration of God, Jacob knew and was able to boldly proclaim that Judah was to be the royal house.

This prophecy is first fulfilled by David (≈1000 BC), who was a descendant of Judah, then his son Solomon ruled in his place. The Davidic Dynasty lasted until about 586 BC and then Babylon ruled over Jerusalem and Judah. However, the Israelites knew of the promise made to Judah by Jacob and continued to look for the Chosen King that would rule. The Jews called this man Messiah (The Hebrew word for Chosen) and He did come during the Roman Empire.

We call Him the Christ (The Greek word for Chosen). Jesus, a man born in the lineage of David and Judah (Matthew 1 and Luke 3), is King of kings, Lord of lords. He rules today and has been ruling in His Kingdom for nearly two millennia.

As our King, we have a responsibility to submit and respect His authority. It begins by believing in Him which includes confessing Him (Romans 10:8, 9), repenting of sins (Acts 2:28), being baptized into the Christ (Galatians 3:27), and living faithfully until death (Revelation 2:10). -

JESUS IN ESTHER

Esther 4:14 NKJV

Esther is a remarkable book within the pages of our Bible. One particular aspects of this book is that God is never mentioned, not even once. I believe this lack of specific mention of God is purposed. If you read Esther, the author emphasizes irony. It is the greatest irony that God is never mentioned, yet it is obvious that He is the architect of the events in the book. It is by God’s Providence that Mordecai was able to foil the assassin’s plot, and that Esther was Queen to save Jews.

The Book of Esther breathes fresh air into the lungs of Christians because it is a strong reminder that God is the architect of our Salvation. Peter in his first letter says that Jesus was foreordained before the foundation for the world, and He was made known for us all. (1 Peter 1:20) Since man first sinned and was destined to die, we all sin and fall short of God’s glory. We’re doomed to an eternal death, but God so loved us that from the very beginning, by His Providence, He orchestrated our salvation through Jesus as He did for the Jews through Esther.

We can benefit from His Providence if we obey. Obedience begins by believing in Jesus which includes confessing Him (Romans 10:8, 9), repenting of our sins (Acts 2:28), being baptized into Christ (Galatians 3:27), and living faithfully until death (Revelation 2:10). -
