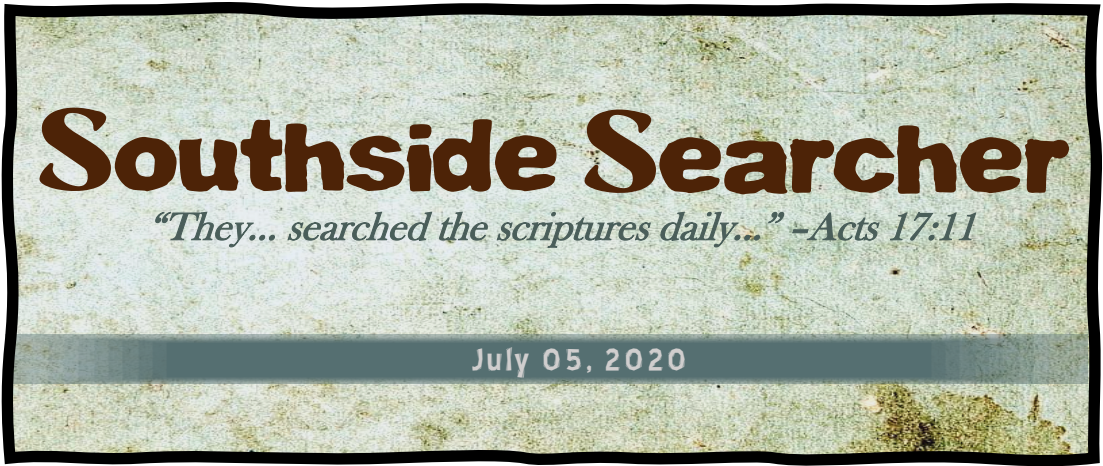

Love Believes All Things

WHILE DESCRIBING AGAPE LOVE in 1 Corinthians chapter thirteen, Paul stated that love “*Believes all things*” (vs. 7).

The idea is not that you must be gullible to be a loving person. It doesn't mean that you just automatically believe everything anyone tells you. It means that it is loving to believe (and hope for) the best about a person or situation until you have all the facts. To prejudge someone based on their job, skin color, accent, age, wardrobe, social standing, financial status, etc is unloving. We are failing to believe the best about someone until we get all the facts. To prejudge the crowd based on the actions of one individual is unloving and dangerous. To prejudge an individual based on the actions of the crowd is equally unloving and dangerous. To prejudge a situation and make accusations against someone before all the facts are in is the opposite of love. These types of judging lead to hating and hatefulness.

The Bible condemns something called “*evil suspicions*” (1 Timothy 6:4, NKJV). Again, it is wrong to question people's motives before we have all the facts. It is wrong to think the worst about someone's mindset before we have the proof. It is wrong and unloving to have a knee-jerk reaction to something we have seen or heard before the proper investigations are made and all the facts are revealed (1 Timothy 5:19-22). And doing so often leads to hateful feelings and harmful actions toward innocent people. May we all strive to be fair and loving toward our fellow man. –
