

# **Praying**

Many struggle with their prayer life because they don't understand how prayer works, or they don't know how to pray. If a lack of diligence is the problem, read 1 Thessalonians 5:17, "*Pray without ceasing*." Understanding the components of prayer will boost our prayer life. 1 Timothy 2:1 lists these components.

<u>Supplications</u>. The root word for "Supplications" is "Supply." We ask God to supply us with the things we need. For example, "*Give us this day our daily bread*" (Matthew 6:11).

<u>Prayers</u>. The Greek word speaks to the worshipful and adoring aspect of praying. It could be properly translated "Praise." This is where we praise and magnify God's name. For example, "*Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name*" (Matthew 6:9). We praise God for Who He is and for what He has done and is doing for us.

<u>Intercessions</u>. This is where we go to God on behalf of others. We intercede for them—the sick, those traveling, those struggling with difficult times, those dealing with discouragement, etc. We pray for Preachers, Elders and other spiritual leaders in the church. We pray for our brethren, our children, the lost. The list goes on.

Giving of Thanks. Thanksgiving is another essential aspect of our prayers. God wants us to be thankful people! "In everything give thanks" (1 Thessalonians 5:18), "In everything by prayer and supplications, with thanksgiving" (Philippians 4:6-7), "Continue earnestly in prayer, being vigilant in it with thanksgiving" (Colossians 4:2). God has blessed us abundantly; there's so much to be thankful for.

# **Hunger & Thirst For Righteousness**

JESUS SAID, "BLESSED ARE those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled" (Matthew 5:6). A few years ago, I saw something I've seen many times over the years. It's nothing new; in fact, most of you are very familiar with the same situation. My little niece began to cry. Was she tired? Was she hurting? NO. She was hungry! The moment she saw her mother pull out her bottle she got a smile on her face and began to reach for it. But my sister-in-law had some trouble getting the cap off the bottle, so the baby began to cry again. Why? Because she strongly desired that milk!

This reminds me of a story my mom likes to tell from time to time. When I was a child and eating baby food from a jar; she would spoon feed it to me as all mothers do. However, it seemed she couldn't feed it to me fast enough and I would scream between each bite! (Things haven't changed much huh? smile). Why did I scream? Because I had a strong desire for the food that was in that jar.

Think about that baby crying for her bottle; think about me screaming for the next bite; if you can fix these mental images in your mind, you will get the mental picture of how Jesus said we should desire spiritual food. Peter drew the same picture when he wrote, "As newborn babes, desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby" (1 Peter 2:2). Do we really desire Bible study with the same intensity? Do we yearn so strongly for another taste of the word, for more spiritual knowledge, that we get upset when we don't get to study it daily (Acts 17:11)? If not, we need to get with it! Paul commanded that we "Understand what the will of the Lord is" (Ephesians 5:17). This takes study!

If babies lacked the desire for their bottle and food, they would refuse it and die. If Christians don't develop a strong desire for more knowledge of the truths found in God's holy word, they will die spiritually! Loving the truth leads to learning the truth, and this will equip us to teach others and avoid sin and error (1 Peter 3:15; 2 Thessalonians 2:9-10).
