CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST!

Paul wrote in Galatians 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me." Crucified with Christ! Our crucifixion is...

Personal. "I" have been crucified. When the Bible speaks of the Christian being crucified, it's speaking of self sacrifice. It's speaking of our willingness to put to death the old man of sin and walk in a "Newness of life" (Romans 6:4) There are great challenges in store for anyone who would choose to follow Jesus in a wicked world. Persecutions from objectors, temptations to sin, the list goes on. We must be willing to give our bodies as living sacrifices, not conforming to the world, but conforming ourselves to Christ and His Gospel (Romans 12:1-2). Jesus said in order to be a true follower of His, we must take up our cross and follow Him (Luke 14:25-33)...

Precious. "It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me." What a precious thing to have Christ living in us. The idea is that we have made such a commitment to follow Christ's

example, and to walk as He walked, in close adherence to his Gospel (2 John 9), that it's as if I am not living at all, but rather Christ is walking the earth once more, this time in my body. Paul prayed "That Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith..." (Ephesians 3:17) It is only through my diligent keeping of His word that Christ can dwell in me (John 14:23), so if I want Him in me, I must spend time with His word, learn it and live it fully....

Practical. "...and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me." Living a crucified life with Christ means living according to his Gospel. This will enhance every aspect of my life here. Whether it be my relationship with my wife (Ephesians 5:22-33), with my children or my parents (Ephesians 6:1-4), with my brethren (Hebrews 10:24-25), with my employer/employee (Titus 2:9-10), with my government (Romans 13), or even with my enemies (Matthew 5:42-48), the Lord's direction in His word will embellish them all. But more important, Heaven is practical! And keeping my eye on that prize will help me overcome any challenge I might face here (2 Corinthians 4:16-18). ☪

IRON SHARPENS IRON

“As iron sharpens iron, so a man sharpens the countenance of his friend.”

- Proverbs 27:17

I'm told that everyone needs a friend they can just "let their hair down" with and be silly. More importantly, we need friends who can provide for us deep, thoughtful and meaningful conversation. Has a friend ever said to you, "let me bounce something off of you?" Now some of my friends might be talking about a basketball, but the statement really expresses a desire to hear your thoughts on an idea; to get your insight on something that is important to them.

Our Proverb above speaks of this very issue. A sharpened countenance implies a sharpened mind, that is, a mind made more active, informed,

creative, and intelligent. A man is poor when he has no friends, but a man may have friends and still be in poverty if he has no friends to whom he can turn for advice and counsel; or to just discuss ideas he deems important.

There is no realm in which this principle is more important than with spiritual and scriptural matters. I've learned some key Bible truths just from sitting around discussing God's word with my friends in their living rooms, or in the foyer at the building. God has provided leaders in the church to provide this type of instruction, both publicly and privately (Ephesians 4:11-14). We miss out on essential Bible teaching when we fail to attend the Bible studies of the church. But preachers, teachers and elders should be your friends by making themselves available to you at any time to discuss a Bible question you may have. 🔍
