MAYAN CALENDAR PROPHECY

It seems there's an endless array of sources when it comes to “indicators” that point to the end of the world. Last year all the buzz was about Harold Camping, and like many before him, his doomsday(s) did not come to pass. Now everyone is hyped up about the Mayan “Long Count” Calendar, with its prediction of December the 21st being either the end or at least a restoration of all things. I read a long complicated explanation of how this is supposed to work and decided it would be a complete waste of paper to reproduce it here. But here are some important things for us to keep in mind (regarding the end of the world) as December the 21st approaches ...

The Destroyer. God has often destroyed peoples and societies in the past. He destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah with fire and hail from above for their going after strange flesh (Homosexuality) among other sins (Jude 1:7). More notably, He destroyed all living things on earth with a world-wide flood because man had come to the point to where they weren't even capable of thinking a decent thought (Genesis 6:5-7). Of course the exceptions were Noah, his family, and the animals he put on the

ark. Our present world will not be destroyed by man, whether by nuclear war-fare, so-called man-made global warming, etc. God will destroy the earth (2 Peter 3:4-7).

The Destruction. Peter describes the destruction of the last day rather clearly. “*But the Day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved...*” (2 Peter 3:10-11). Keeping this destruction in mind, Peter asked this question, “*Therefore... what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness*” (vs. 11b). He went on in verse 10 to describe how the very elements will be melted. Complete destruction!

The Date. All the Bible says about when the end of the world will come is that no one knows! Only the Father (Matthew 24:36). It will take most by surprise, that's why it is spoken of several times as coming like a thief in the night (Matthew 24:43; 1 Thessalonians 5:2; 2 Peter 3:10). Obey the Gospel and remain faithful to the Lord and you'll be ready. 🔍

We must not be like this in our daily lives, and we must do better than this in business (the workplace).
As Christians, we must work with our hands "What is good" (Ephesians 4:28). The Greek word for "Good" speaks of the quality of the work we do; it must be both honest and honorable work. I can think of many jobs one might have that is dishonorable. Should a Christian work in a liquor store, or such like? I think not! Don't buy junk, and don't sell junk! 🔍
