SATAN

There is much we don't know about Satan, but there is also much we can learn about him from various parts of scripture. Let's focus in on three essential truths regarding our adversary from Genesis chapter three. There, we learn that Satan is...

DECEPTIVE. The serpent said to Eve, "You will not surely die" (Genesis 3:4). God had said they would die if they ate of the tree of knowledge of good and evil (Genesis 2:17), but Satan is trying to deceive Eve into thinking otherwise. The Lord warned us that Satan is the father of lies (John 8:44). Satan is trying to get us to sin and lose our souls. Sin itself is deceptive (Hebrews 3:12-13). We are warned there not to be hardened by sin. Don't be deceived by the temptations that present themselves to you on a daily basis. That little lie will cost you your soul. That one drink will lead to disaster. That one puff can lead to a lifetime of slavery. That one night out on the town with worldly friends can cost you more than you ever wanted to pay. Eve was deceived by Satan (1 Timothy 2:14; 2 Corinthians 11:3).

DETERMINED. Even after Eve had informed Satan of what God had told them regarding that tree, Satan

persisted. He was determined to pervert all the good God had created. We usually reserve the word "Pervert" for the "Lowest class" of sexual sinners. But anytime we violate one of God's commands we are perverts. Lying is a perversion of truth. Stealing is a perversion of God's commandments. Gossip is a perversion of God's instructions (Romans 1:29-30). Forsaking the assemblies is a perversion of God's will (Hebrews 10:25). It doesn't matter which sin he gets you with, Satan is determined to take you down, and he's contented to do it with a "Clean sin" as a "Dirty" one.

DEFEATED. God promised Satan that the woman's seed would, "Bruise your head" (Genesis 3:15). This is a prophecy of the Messiah, the Christ, and was ultimately accomplished at Calvary (Hebrews 2:14-16). Satan was deceptive and determined, but the Lord defeated him with each temptation, each time responding to the devil with the phrase, "It is written" (Matthew 4:1-11). The psalmist said, "Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You" (Psalm 119:11). Memorizing key passages of scripture is one of the most essential keys to defeating Satan's onslaught against your eternal soul!

I DIDN'T MEAN TO SCARE YOU?

“Now as he reasoned about righteousness, self-control, and the judgment to come, Felix was afraid...”
 –Acts 24:25

Every now and again someone begins to talk about the fear of hell not being a legitimate reason for someone to obey the Gospel. The conversation has been extended by some to the area of preaching. That is, some claim that we shouldn't preach so much on hell claiming that we don't want to scare people into obeying the Gospel. So now, not only can you not obey the Gospel with the fear of hell in your heart, but preachers need to begin avoiding the subject of hell, lest they “Scare someone into obeying.”

Nonsense! The Bible, especially the Gospel, and especially Jesus' teachings while on earth; all of these are filled with teachings and warnings regarding eternal punishment! I know other incentives are given, but the fear of hell

is certainly a valid one. In the passage above (Acts 24:25), it's clear that the thought of Judgment struck Felix's heart with fear. Should Paul have said, “I didn't mean to scare you?” We certainly have no record of such a thing being said, or even implied.

As far as preaching goes, Jesus certainly preached “Hell, fire, and brimstone” sermons. In fact, in Matthew 25:46 He placed the fear of “Everlasting punishment” on the same footing as “Eternal life.” Paul made it clear that the “Terror of the Lord” on judgment day prompted him to “Persuade men” (2 Corinthians 5:10-11).

Preaching should be balanced with love, grace, and eternal punishment (2 Timothy 4:1-4). One may obey the Gospel with a mixed bag of thoughts in his heart – love for God, desire for heaven, and fear of hell. All are legitimate reasons for responding to the Gospel. 🔍
