NUMBERS Michael Pickford

This article isn't about the fourth book of Moses. It's about people. We must have the proper perspective about numbers in relation to people.

A Harmful Perspective. Many churches make the mistake of playing the numbers game. They measure success and growth based purely on how many people they have. The danger here is the temptation to lay aside bible authority in order to "Fill the building." Many churches have given themselves over to the ways of denominationalism. They have turned to food, fun, and frolic to get the crowds. "God must bless this," they reason, "After all; look at how much we've grown." But remember, those who transgress the doctrine of Christ do not have God, regardless of how numerous they are (2 John 9). Another danger here is in an individual thinking a church is right simply because it is so large. "That many people couldn't be wrong," they reason. But remember, the Lord said "few" would find life (Matthew 7:13-14). The standard of right and wrong is not how many or how few believe a thing, it's the word of God (John 12:48).

A Hopeful Perspective. We are to take the Gospel to "every creature," to

"The end of the earth" (Mark 16:15; Acts 1:8). We should be trying to teach the Gospel to our family, friends, neighbors, co-workers, peers, etc. Sometimes we get discouraged because it seems so few are convinced to obey the Gospel. Remember again, there are few who will be willing to make the difficult sacrifices required to obey and follow the Lord (Matthew 7:13-14). Even Jesus, the master teacher, converted relatively few during His earthly ministry. Keep at it, if you convert one soul it will be worth it all.

A Holy Perspective. I dealt with a harmful perspective in the first point, but some take this to the other extreme, maintaining that God isn't concerned about numbers at all. The truth is, God is concerned about numbers. He sent His Son to die for the "World" (John 3:16). God is not willing that any should perish, He desires all men to be saved (2 Peter 3:9; 1 Timothy 2:4). If it is our Father's desire that all be saved, and He was willing to hang His Son on the cross to create the possibility, then certainly our desire should be to diligently work at converting folks to the Lord regardless of the sacrifices we might have to make of time, money, and rejections. 🔍

JESUS THE CARPENTER

“Is this not the carpenter, the Son of Mary, and brother of James, Joses, Judas, and Simon? And are not His sisters here with us? So they were offended at Him....”

—Mark 6:3

Occasionally I will hear someone say that the Bible never actually speaks of Jesus being a carpenter, only that He was the son of Joseph, who was a carpenter. But they have overlooked Mark 6:3 which states that Jesus did in fact work as a carpenter, just like His father.

Years ago there was a popular bumper sticker that said, “My boss is a Jewish Carpenter.” Of course the intended message was that these folks serve Jesus. The fact is, Jesus was a physical carpenter while on this earth. Like most Jewish boys, He followed in his father’s footsteps, learned his father’s trade, and worked as a carpenter.

But our Lord’s most important work

was as a different kind of carpenter. In Matthew 16:18 He promised that “On this rock I will build my church.” As a spiritual carpenter, he was going to build something... His church! We find that He fulfilled this promise. Acts 2:47 informs us that He added to the church daily those who were being saved. Those who were being saved in the context were those who repented and were baptized in Jesus’ name (Acts 2:38).

The rich and famous of our time seek out the best, most renowned carpenters to build their dream house. They then glory in the fact that “Such and such, the famous and talented carpenter built my house!” But that house, regardless of how glorious, will one day burn up (2 Peter 3:10-11).

Why not be a part of a building made not with hands, a building that offers eternal life? Why not obey the Lord in baptism and become part of that everlasting house, the eternal kingdom that He, the master carpenter, built? 🔑
