HEAR HIM!

On the mount of transfiguration, in the presence of Jesus, Peter, James, John, Moses, and Elijah, God said about Jesus, “*This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!*” (Matthew 17:5). It is a great tragedy that many today, even many who claim to follow Jesus, refuse to hear and heed Him in various ways. We need to hear Jesus on...

Marriage. In Matthew 19:9, Jesus condemned the then prevalent practice of divorcing for just about any cause. He also condemned remarriage for anyone who had been put away. Only those who had put away their spouse for fornication could lawfully remarry. Jesus also condemned homosexual marriages in this context. When the Jews questioned Him about marriage and divorce, Jesus stated, “*Have you not read that He who made them at the beginning ‘made them male and female.’*” (vs 5). God’s intention was that one man marries one woman and that they remain married for life (vs 6). Those today claiming to be Christians yet advocating for homosexual marriages are failing to hear Jesus. Homosexuality is vile, unnatural, shameful, and an abomination to our Creator (Romans 1:26-27; Lev. 18:22).

Morality. Jesus stated, “For out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies. These are the things which defile a man...” (Matthew 15:19-20). Today’s modern news is filled with stories about rape, murders, unwanted pregnancies, STD’s etc. A couple living together before marriage has become in many ways the norm (Hebrews 13:4). The murder rate is still high (Galatians 5:21). Internet porn is still on the rise, even among religious people (Gal 5:19 – lewdness, lasciviousness). “Christians” are still entertaining themselves with the sins of the world (Rom 1:32; Psalm 101:3). Foul language is becoming more and more fluent on the TV and in the work place (Colossians 3:8). Oh how we need to stop and listen to Jesus!

Money. “And He said to them, ‘Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses’” (Luke 12:15). Greed is all around us. Families, children, honesty, and spiritual commitments too often take a back seat to the pursuit of the almighty dollar. Instead of one Nation under God, we have become one Nation under greed. Hear Jesus! (Matt. 6:19-24).



The context of Matthew 7:1-6 will show that Jesus is not condemning all judging; He is condemning hypocritical judging. It’s like the drunkard condemning the drunkard for being a drunkard. Jesus actually commanded us to judge in verse 5 when He told us to remove the speck from our brother’s eye (after removing the plank from our own eye). We are not to judge hypocritically, but we have been commanded by Jesus to “Judge with righteous judgment” (John 7:24). -MP
