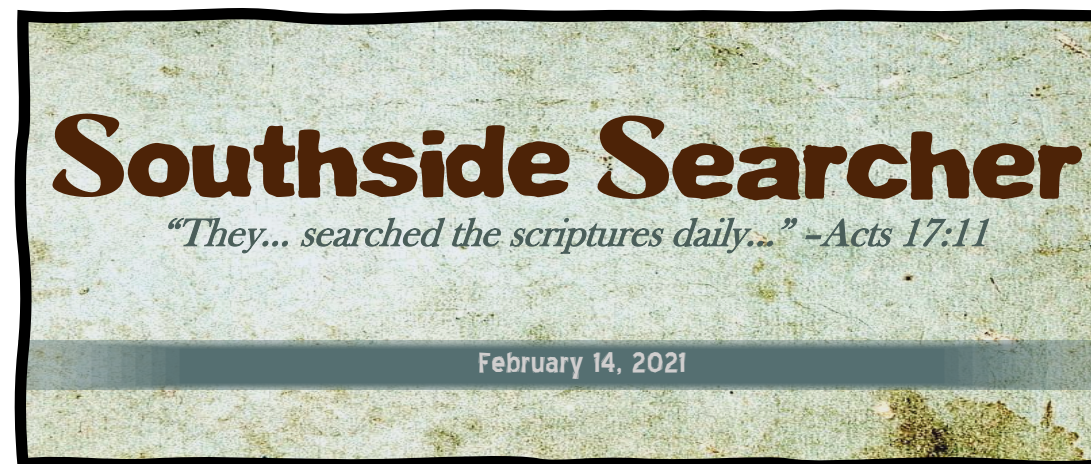

Dying Well

My doctor once told me that of the many deaths he had witnessed, “Those who die in light of the Christian religion die in a much different way.”

What does it mean to die well? Perhaps if one died in service to his country, he died well. Perhaps if someone gave his life to save another, he died well. Perhaps if someone died with little pain or suffering, he died well. But do these fully capture the essence of dying well? In blessing Israel, Balaam uttered an impressive prayer, “*Let me die the death of the righteous, And let my end be like his!*” (Numbers 23:10). Now that would be dying well—as a righteous servant of God! But if one is going to die as a righteous servant of God, he must serve God righteously.

Everyone has an appointment with death (Hebrews 9:27), and we all know it, “*For the living know that they will die*” (Ecclesiastes 9:5). In 1 Thessalonians 4:13-14, Paul discussed those who die “*In Jesus.*” The only way to truly die well is to die in Christ. Otherwise, you will die “*as others who have no hope.*” Christians die much differently than those in the world. They die with hope! Their hope is for eternal glory when they pass from this life. Paul taught that those who die in Christ have not ceased to exist; they will be glorified with Christ.

When the deceased is a child of God the sadness of death is ultimately swallowed up with joy. “*Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on. Yes, says the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors, and their works follow them*” (Revelation 14:13). Notice that they die “*in the Lord.*” The following passages teach us how to get “*In Christ*” so we can die well. (Galatians 3:26-27; Romans 6:1-6).

What's Missing In Hell?

Torments, darkness, suffering, and other terrible things are found in hell. Many people have grave misconceptions about hell. These misconceptions can be corrected when we consider what's missing in hell.

1) Atheists Are Missing. The atheist thinks he is wise for denying God's existence. He is a fool for doing so considering the profound evidence that surrounds him in the beauty, grandeur, and perfect order of creation (Psalm 14:1; 19:1-6; Romans 1:18-23). But when he meets the Lord on judgment day, he will most certainly believe before being cast into hell. He won't be an atheist there!

2) Good Times Are Missing. Some speak of wanting to go to hell so they can party with all their friends. Sorry, there will be no "good times" there. Only darkness, torments, and wailing (Mark 9:42ff).

3) The Obedient Are Missing. Those who obey Christ, obey the gospel, and serve the Lord faithfully until death will be in heaven, not hell (Hebrews 5:8-9; Revelation 2:10). But those who *"Do not obey the gospel...will be punished with everlasting destruction"* (2 Thessalonians 1:7-9).

4) The End Is Missing. Not only is hell filled with unimaginable suffering, but it will never end. You will beg for annihilation, but it will not come. The suffering of hell is just as "eternal" and "everlasting" as the glories of heaven will be for the saved (Matthew 25:46; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9).

5) Help From Satan Is Missing. Some foolishly believe that if they live wickedly in this life Satan will be pleased and will take it easy on them in hell. This stems from the false notion that Satan oversees hell. The everlasting fires of hell were originally prepared for the devil and his angels (Matthew 25:41). Satan will be suffering the full intensity of hell's fury alongside everyone else.

6) The Second Chance Is Missing. Once you take your last breath in this life your eternal fate is sealed. We will be judged based on what we did while *"in the body"* (2 Corinthians 5:10). Purgatory is a myth not found in the Bible. No one can pray you out, pay you out, or get you out by being baptized for you after you have died.

7) The Glory Of The Lord Is Missing. When you enter hell, it will not merely be about the punishment you are suffering, it will also be about the glories of heaven you are missing. The disobedient will be separated FROM the presence of the Lord and FROM the glory of His power (2 Thessalonians 1:7-9).
