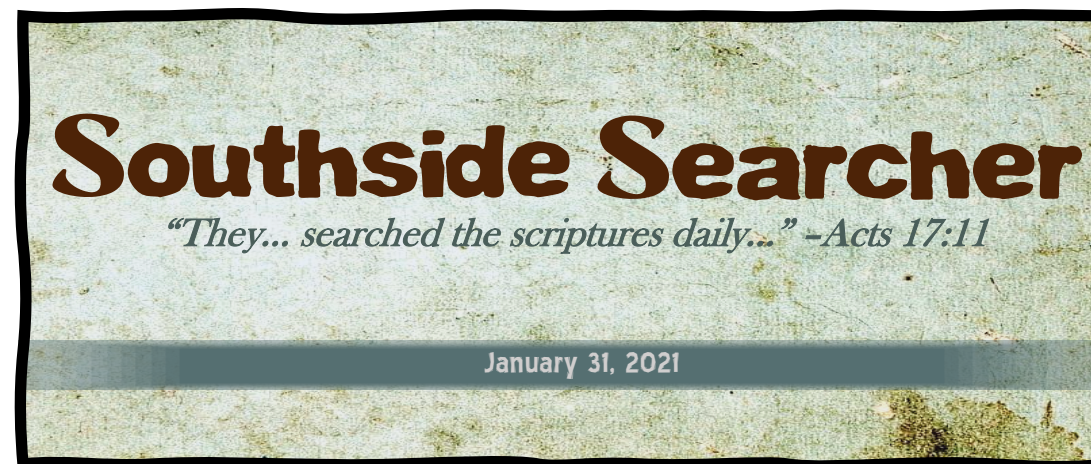

Don't Be Stupid

FOLKS CALL OTHERS NAMES out of anger, contempt, rudeness, prejudice, or just plain meanness. These motives are always wrong. But God called people names, not for any of the above reasons, but to show people what they are— in hopes that it will cause them to change. God loves them and desires their repentance and salvation (2 Peter 3:9).

Proverbs 12:1 says, “Whoever loves instruction loves knowledge, but he who hates correction is *stupid*.” God called people “stupid” to instruct them to do better. Those identified as “stupid” are those who hate *correction*. All scripture is given for *correction* (2 Timothy 3:16-17). Those who ignore or deny parts of God’s word are stupid people (so says God – because He loves them).

“Christians” who condone the occasional alcoholic drink are stupid for ignoring the prohibitions against it (Proverbs 23:31-32; 1 Peter 4:3; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11), and the potential earthly dangers it creates.

“Christians” who condone homosexuality are stupid for ignoring God’s condemnation of it (Leviticus 18:22; Romans 1:25-28; 1 Corinthians 6:9-11).

“Christians” who defend lying if it is done for a good purpose or cause ignore God’s condemnation of “all” “liars” (Revelation 21:8).

“Churches” that engage in unauthorized religious practices because they “think” the practices please God are stupid for ignoring God’s clear condemnation of such (Colossians 3:17; 2 John 1:9; Matthew 7:21-23).

Call it “name-calling” or whatever, but it is essential for our wrongdoings to be identified and corrected. We need tough love! Especially where God’s word is concerned. Don’t be stupid, obey God!
